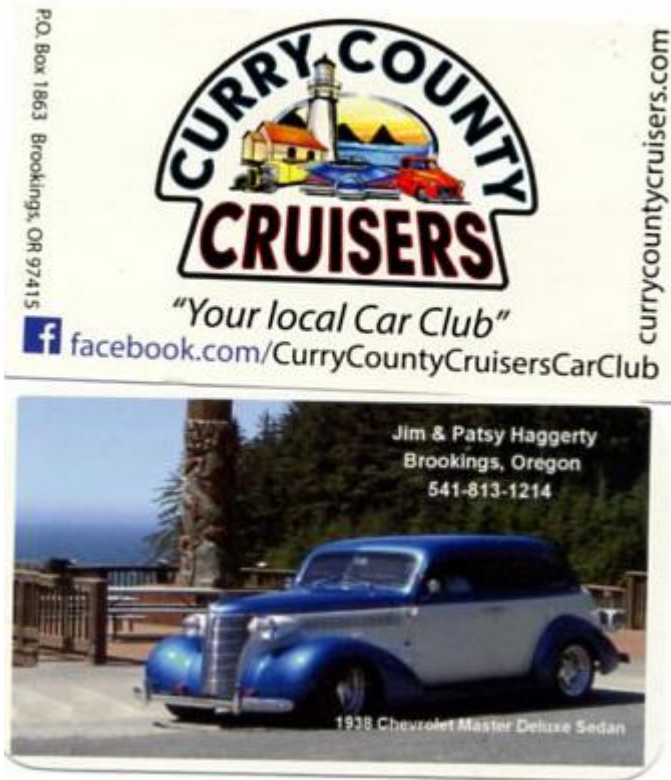
We also discussed the purchase of two sided business cards, one side with Curry County Cruisers club information, and the other side with the club member's car and contact info.
